NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Veteran Dog

(For Dogs/Bitches that are 7 years old and older)

(Note: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules states that neutered dogs and spayed bitches may compete in the Veteran Classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competition beyond Best of Breed)

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Awards of Merit: At the discretion of the judge up to (4) four Awards of Merit may be awarded from the Best of Breed Competition.

CLASSIFICATION- NON REGULAR CLASSES--MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES **> SUNDAY ONLY FOR NATIONAL SPECIALTY <**

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG—For Stud Dogs and no less than two and no more than four of their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. The Stud dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes but it is not required, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class, and **MUST** be shown in the ring with the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its breed. Get only to be judged on the merits of the Get. Each dog making up the Get must be individually entered in one of the Regular Classes or Best of Breed Competition. Entry fee for Stud Dog is \$20.00 (as a unit).

BROOD BITCH—Same as Stud Dog Class, except replace "Stud Dog" with "Brood Bitch" and "Get" with "Produce".
Note: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

The term "dog" in Rally will refer to either sex.

A Qualifying Score is required for ALL prizes in the Regular Classes.

A dark green Qualifying ribbon will be given to all dogs with a Qualifying Score.

There is no refund for bitches in season.

Move-ups will be allowed in Rally Classes.

SWEEPSTAKES (each event)

Sweepstakes is open to all Miniature Bull Terriers that on the day of the show, will be at least 6 months and under 18 months of age. Champions of Record are not allowed to compete. Sweepstakes classes will be judged prior to the regular breed classes. Winners of the Sweepstakes classes will compete in Best in Sweepstakes & Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes. Dogs shown in Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class."

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES (each event)

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all AKC registered Miniature Bull Terriers that are at least seven (7) years old on the day of Veteran Sweepstakes (entrants may be spayed or neutered). Winners of the Veteran Sweepstakes classes will compete for Best in Veteran Sweepstake & Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Veteran Sweepstakes. Dogs shown in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in one of the regular classes or at the regular entry fee. Indicate your Veteran Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided.

DIVISION OF STAKE FOR SWEEPS & VETERAN SWEEPS

35% of total entry fees will be retained by the Club for expenses. The remaining 65% will be divided as follows: First Place - 40%; Second Place - 30%; Third Place - 20%; Fourth Place - 10%. Any money not claimed or won shall be retained by the MBTCA.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP (Friday only)

Entry blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information; otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS. For Boys & Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS. For Boys & Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Junior Showmanship continued:

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS. For Boys & Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS. For Boys & Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS. For Boys & Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS. For Boys & Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won Three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS. For boys & girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won ten First Places with competition present in an Open Class at a licensed or member show. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change the entry without charge the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants re-turn to the Open class to compete for the following year.

The winner of the Novice Class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same show provided the win is the third (3rd) first place award with competition and further providing there are one or more Junior Handlers competing in the Open Class.

Each dog handled in a regular Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the breed classes at this show or entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog that must be withdrawn for good and sufficient reason, such as a bitch in season, or a veterinarian's excuse, may be replaced by another dog meeting the ownership requirements. Such substitution must be required in writing stating the reason for the substitution and must be accompanied by an Official AKC Form. All such requests must be made at least a half hour prior to the judging of any regular class at the show. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER HANDLED SERIES (All Conformation Events)

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned, co-owned or exhibited by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in this competition.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed/Variety competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed.

AKC-NOHS continued:

- If the Best of Breed winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
- If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If the regular show Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog who competed in Best of Breed including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Best of Breed for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series.
- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winners are ineligible since it was defeated.
- No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*

***A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any during the cluster/weekend.*

Don't forget to check the box at the bottom of your entry form as to your AKC NOHS eligibility. It must be done at the time of entry.

AKC Sanctioned

Section 1- Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event.

Section 2 – Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed or member dog shows at the option of the show giving club.
- Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for all entries.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.*

Entry Fee: \$15.00 (including AKC recording fee of \$2.00 for each dog paid to the American Kennel Club.)
